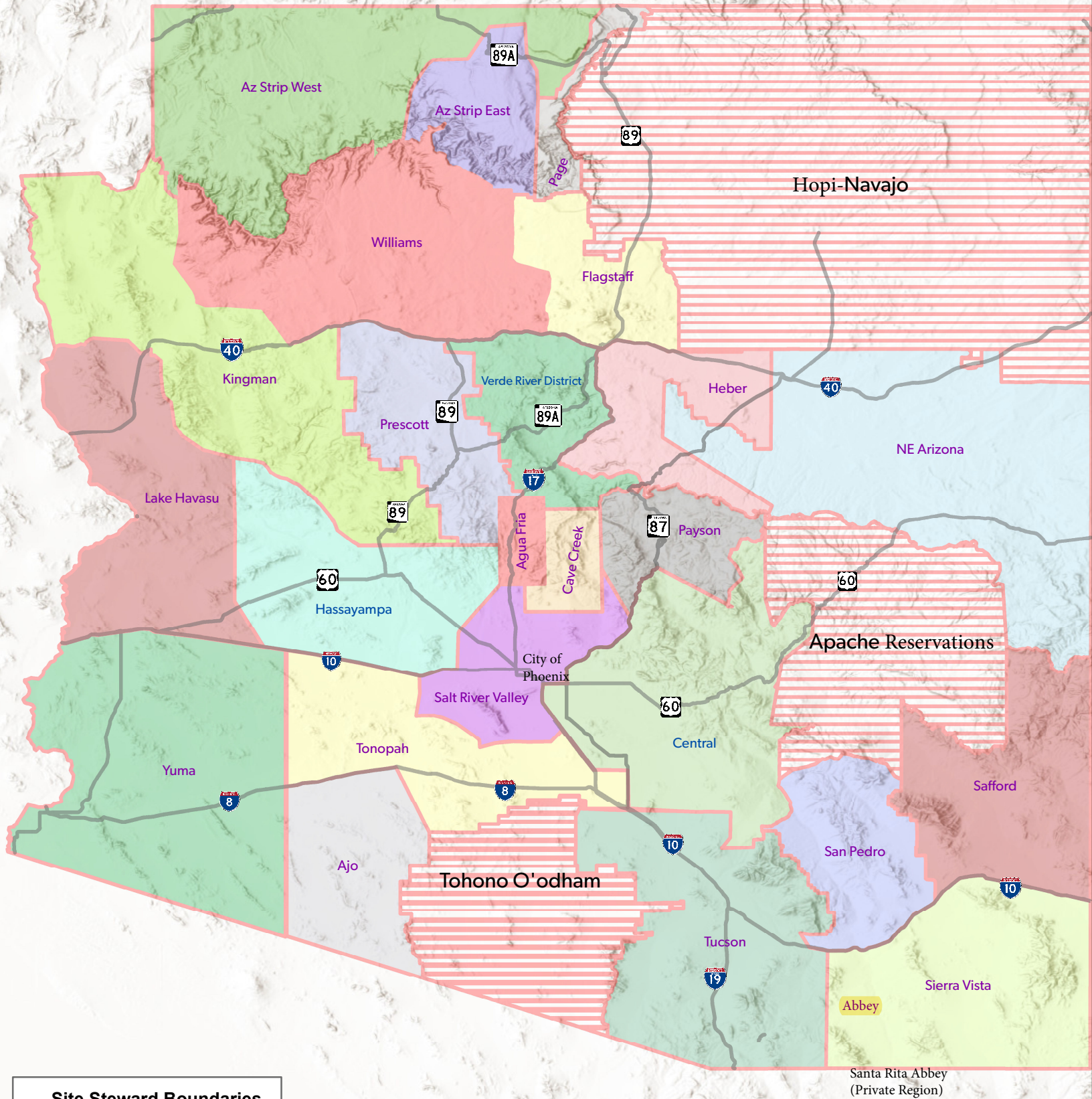

The Regional Coordinator is a volunteer leadership position within the program. The State is divided into geographic regions. As of 2020, there are twenty-five (25) regions. Each region has a volunteer that stepped up to take on additional duties to ensure the success of the program. A RC handles the daily management of a region including assigning Stewards to sites to monitor, making sure all Stewards in their region have the proper documents to volunteer with various land managers and that Stewards are submitting their hours in the program's database.
