History on the Rocks: A Pre-historic Hiking Tour of Box Canyon South Mountain Park

Come join Ranger Brian Krauss on this tour of Box Canyon, an area of frequent use in antiquity at the base of South Mountain. See the history and clues into Hohokam lifeways written on the rocks and buried underfoot in Box Canyon, a refuge for Ancient Sonoran Desert Peoples in ages past and today. The tour involves hiking and scrambling over boulders, so please come prepared to be mobile and stay hydrated. The length of the hike is 2-3 miles with a total elevation change of about 300 feet. There are restrooms at the trailhead.


